THE OLD HORNS 68 WARNER PLACE, E2 7DA

The pub where the Krays spent their last night before being arrested. Now a Montessori school.

ST MATTHEW'S CHURCH

Where Ronnie's and Violet's funerals took place, round the corner from the Carpenter's Arms.

ST JAMES THE GREAT POLLARD ROW, E2 6LJ

The church where Reggie married Frances Shea on 19 April 1965. It has now been converted into flats.

CEDRA COURT CAZENOVE RD, NI6 6AT

Where Ronnie and Reggie both owned flats, one bove the other. Captured in a famous getty photo.

97 EVERING ROAD

STOKE NEWINGTON, NI6 7QA

Where hitman Jack the Hat was killed by Reggie in 1967.

THE CARPENTER'S ARMS

73 CHESHIRE ST, E2 6EG

One of the most notorious pubs in East London where The Firm assembled for orders and spent time socialising. The twins eventually bought it in 1967 for their mother Violet.

DRYSDALE ST

GREAT FASTERN BEAR GREAT EASTERN ST, EC2A 3NT 24 AUGUST - 23 SEPTEMBER

E PELLICCI'S CAFE

332 BETHNAL GREEN RD, E2 OAG

WEAVER'S

FIELDS

A famous East End greasy spoon café, very much part of Bethnal Green folklore, where the Kravs were regulars. A scene in the film was shot here (and features in the trailer).

BARNSLEY ST

REPTON BOYS **BOXING CLUB** CHESHIRE ST, E2 6EG

London's oldest boxing gym, established in 1884. The twins took up amateur boxing here, achieving success from a young age.

VALLANCE ROAD

178 VALLANCE RD, E2 6HR

The Kray family moved to 178 Vallance Road in 1938. This would become the twins' operations room', also known as Fort Vallance.

UNDERWOOD ST

THE BLIND BEGGAR

337 WHITECHAPEL RD, EIIBU

The infamous pub where Ronnie killed the Richardson gang member George Cornell on 9 March 1966.

GENESIS CINEMA

MILE END. EI 4UJ

The Krays famously turned up to the premiere of Sparrows Can't Sing starring Barbara Windsor, as she was going out with (then later married) Kray friend Ronnie Knight. Some of Sparrows Can't Sing was shot at one of the Krays' clubs.


REDMANS RD

ESMERALDA'S BARN

WILTON PLACE, SWIX 8RL

The fashionable gambling club owned by the twins - as they expanded their empire into the West End - where gangsters mixed with actors, famous sportsmen and showbiz celebrities such as Barbara Windsor and Joan Collins.
