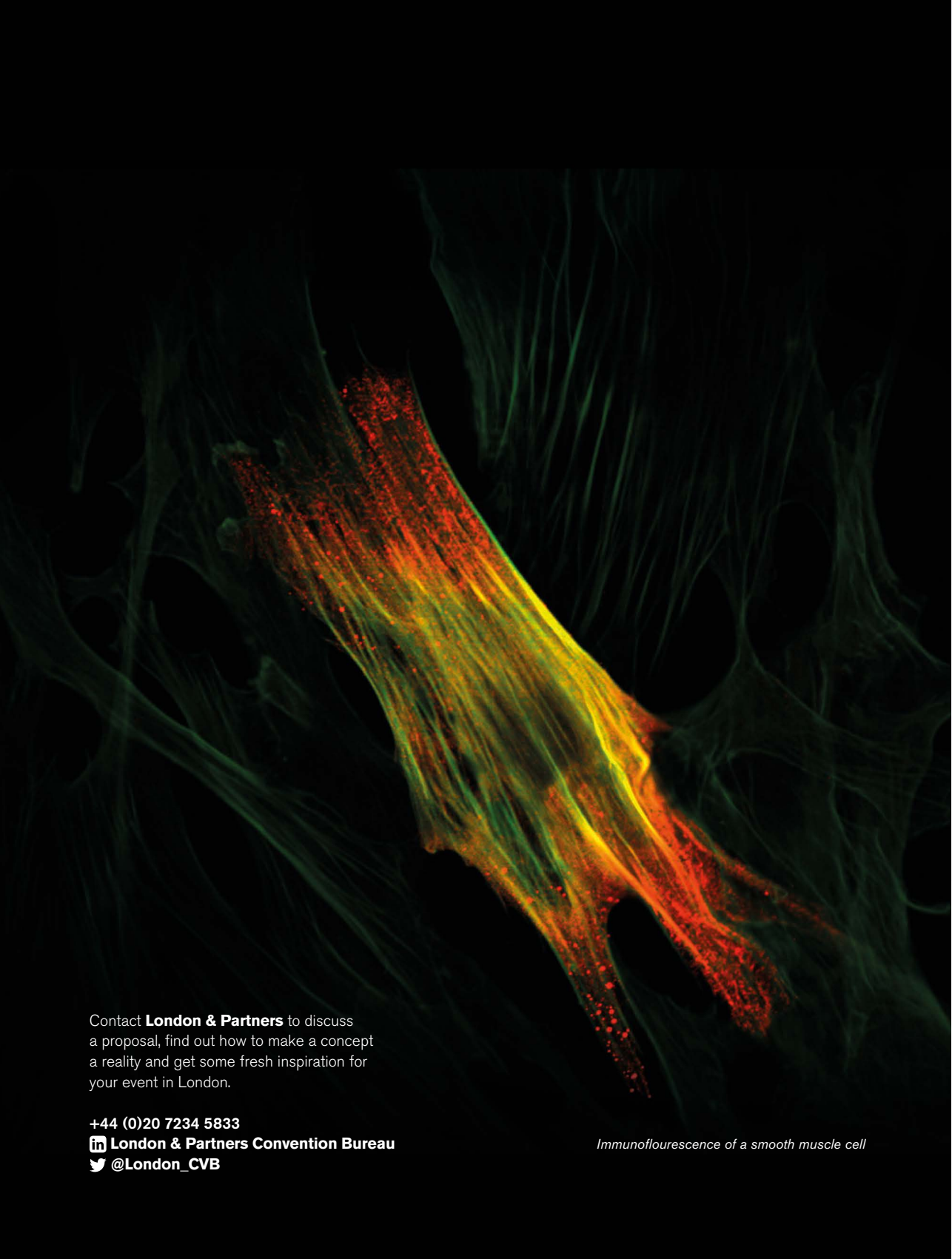

# Why London

A world-class city with centuries of history, a vibrant culture, first-rate connections to the rest of the world, and medical excellence – London has it all. England's capital is home to an efficient transport system, a variety of hotels and venues and one-of-a-kind attractions. This paired with the city's expertise in events organisation make it an internationally appealing destination.

## A cutting edge capital

In life sciences, technology, finance, creative industries and retail, London leads the way. Skills in these areas are concentrated in hubs, with life sciences centred around Euston, tech expertise in Shoreditch, creative excellence in Soho and finance amid the glass and steel towers of Canary Wharf. The proximity of these hubs has inspired cross-sector innovation in new industries such as FinTech, AdTech, MedTech, FashionTech, EdTech and more, and continuing investment ensures that London stays ahead of the game in intellectual capital and innovation.

## Pharma credentials

Device experts Smith & Nephew, GSK and AstraZeneca are just a few of the medical companies that call London home. The city is home to 120 biopharma companies, 1,500 biomedical researchers, 14 teaching hospitals and 50 clinical research centres. In addition, there are almost 90 commercial, research and development and manufacturing medical companies in and around London.

Many key agencies and regulators are also based in London, including the European Medicines Agency, Medical and Healthcare Products Regulatory Agency, National Institute for Health Research (NIHR) and Medical Research Council (MRC). The regulations that make the events industry what it is – safe, reliable, cutting edge and dedicated – are created in London. It comes as no surprise that London is the number one choice for medical meetings and events.



## The opportunity

The strong medical presence in the capital provides a wealth of opportunity for event planners in the sector. Organisers can enjoy outstanding networking potential and access to the expertise and minds behind impressive innovation and research. London offers the opportunity to do business in a city that leads the world and ensures a return on investment.

## Medical excellence

The Golden Triangle links the health science centres in three of the capital's premier academic institutions – University College London, Imperial College and King's College – with Oxford and Cambridge. They are supported by organisations such as the world's largest medical health charity Wellcome Trust, which funds research into human and animal health. These institutions are at the heart of MedCity, which exists to promote and grow the life sciences investment, entrepreneurship and industry. A product of this collaboration is the new Francis Crick Institute, where 1,250 scientists will be working in a cutting edge centre of biomedical research and innovation.

## Venues for rousing events

Inspiring venues are a big part of London's appeal, with phenomenal choice in more than 1,000 venues and 140,000 hotel rooms in styles that range from budget to boutique across the city. Wellcome Collection is where event space, library and museum make an inspirational combination. Many other medical institutions also have first class spaces, including 1 Wimpole Street, home of the Royal Society of Medicine; BMA House and the Royal College of Physicians. With the help of introductions from London & Partners, some of these respected institutions can provide speakers, ensuring your conference is a memorable experience.

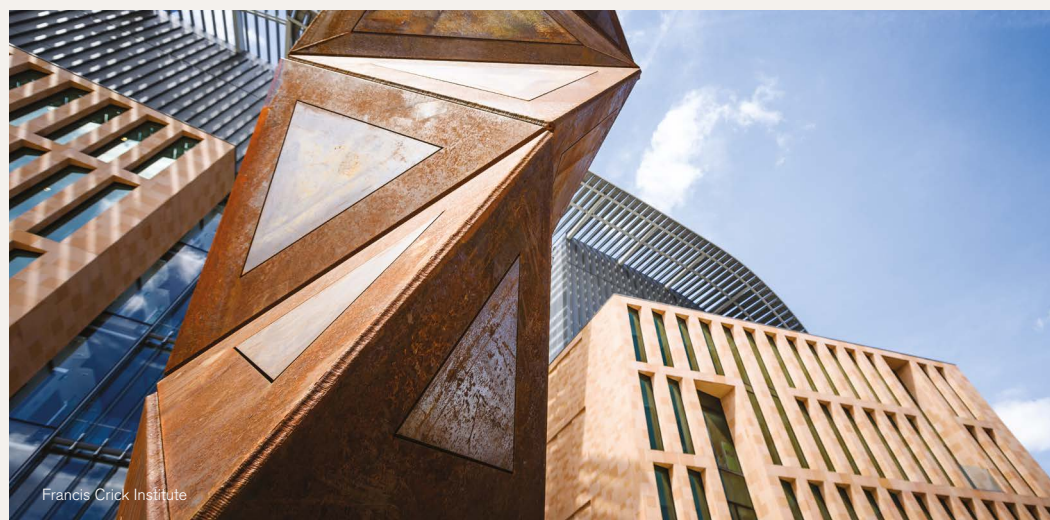

The BRCA 2 test was led by Prof. Naznine Rahman at the Institute of Cancer Research, creating a new way of looking at cancer testing for it, and a cheaper delivery mechanism.

The 100,000 Genome Project, run by Genomics England in London, will sequence 100,000 genomes from 70,000 people to give the National Health Service a genomic medicine service, looking at causes, diagnoses and treatments of disease.

In 2009, the first embryo grown baby, screened to ensure it did not contain the BRCA1 gene, was born at University College London.

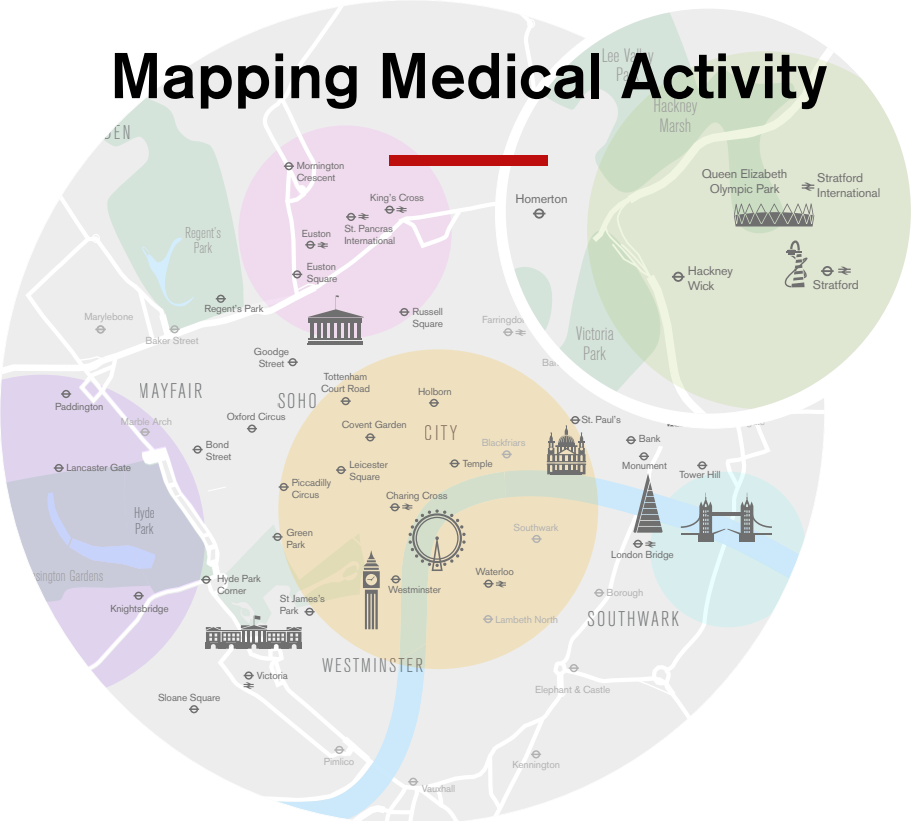

# Mapping Medical Activity



From Paddington to Hammersmith, West London hosts a powerful mix of research and development, manufacturing, academic study and healthcare, including Astra Zeneca, Genomic Medicine Centre and Imperial College Health Partners.

Westminster and the City host three of the industry's four regulatory bodies based in London: Medical Research Council, Medicines and Healthcare Products Regulatory Agency and National Institute for Health Research.

South of the Thames near Tower Bridge, pharma companies rub shoulders with King's Health Partners and the Cell and Gene Therapy Catapult, created to lead the way in cell and gene therapy.

The area around King's Cross St. Pancras, Euston and Bloomsbury is known as the Knowledge Quarter, comprising 35 organisations that cover culture, science, academia, research and media, including the British Library, Birkbeck College, the Francis Crick Institute, Google and the Institute of Physics.

East London is also contributing to London's medical excellence, with scientific research and development hub Londoneast-uk Business and Technical Park in Dagenham; and UCL East, the university's planned campus at Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park. This aims to overcome the conventional barriers between research, education, innovation, public engagement and collaboration.

# Practical Information for your Medical Meeting in London



## Getting here

With five international airports – Heathrow, Gatwick, London City, Stansted and Luton - London has first class connections with the rest of the world. It serves 396 destinations in all, supplied by a variety of legacy and low cost carriers that ensures there is transportation to match every budget. In addition, Eurostar departs from St. Pancras International rail station, giving easy access to the rest of Europe.



## Getting around

London's public transport network covers the length and breadth of the city and offers several options. The easiest way for delegates to travel around the city is with an Oyster Card, a contactless smart ticket that gives users a 30% discount across London's transport network. The new Night Tube has extended London Underground services; it is now open, giving 24-hour service on selected lines on Fridays and Saturdays. Visitors can take in the city at a more leisurely pace on Santander bikes, which can be found at docking stations all over the city. The bikes offer the opportunity to make getting from A to B a team building activity. Other options include DLR's driverless trains to Canary Wharf and ExCeL London, black cabs or a view from the river on the Thames Clipper. ## Investment brings improvements

From 2018, Crossrail – to be known as the Elizabeth Line – will increase London's rail capacity by 10%, it will radically cut journey times and allow passengers to get right across London on one train. For example, delegates will be able to reach Custom House (for ExCeL London) from Heathrow in 44 minutes. In addition, new rail services will be bringing the rest of Europe closer, from late 2017, Eurostar will be operating between London St. Pancras and Amsterdam, stopping at Brussels, Antwerp, Rotterdam and Schiphol Airport. Deutsche Bahn will also be running trains direct from Frankfurt, Cologne, Amsterdam and Rotterdam to London.



## Venues

Whether you are looking for historic or purpose built, outdoor space or superb views, there are venues that answer to every requirement. The QEII Centre (capacity 2 to 1,300) is within sight of Parliament Square and a recent refurbishment puts it at the cutting edge; Guildhall Great Hall (6 to 900) provides beautiful and elegant surroundings; ExCeL London offers an incredible 100,000m<sup>2</sup> of flexible event space including London's International Convention Centre; home of the British Medical Association, BMAHouse (25 to 320), has 25 meeting spaces in a Grade II Listed building, plus courtyard and garden; and the purpose-built Royal College of Physicians (18 to 440) provides a modern alternative.



## Accommodation

The city's hotels provide warm hospitality in properties from budget to 5-star comfort. London has 140,000 hotel rooms, with another 16,000 anticipated by 2018. Radisson Blu Edwardian at Heathrow covers arrivals at Terminals 1, 2 and 3, and covering Terminal 5 is Hilton London Heathrow Airport Terminal 5. Novotel London West in Hammersmith is an ideal West London venue, or more central are the purpose-built Park Plaza County Hall London opposite the Houses of Parliament and The Bloomsbury, close to King's Cross and the Knowledge Quarter.

Many of London's 48 colleges and universities are also available for good value bed & breakfast accommodation between June and September, giving delegates the chance to live on-campus during their stay.

## Compliant with the code

**There are numerous London venues and hotels that are compliant with the ABPI Code of Practice for the Pharmaceutical Industry. With London & Partners, these venues will support organisers in requirements such as limited spend per head, signage or management of registration fee payment.**

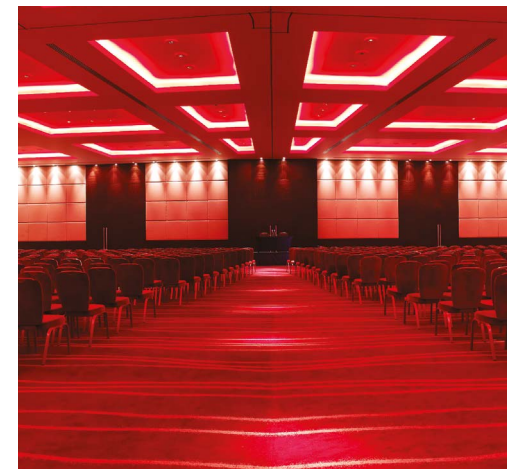

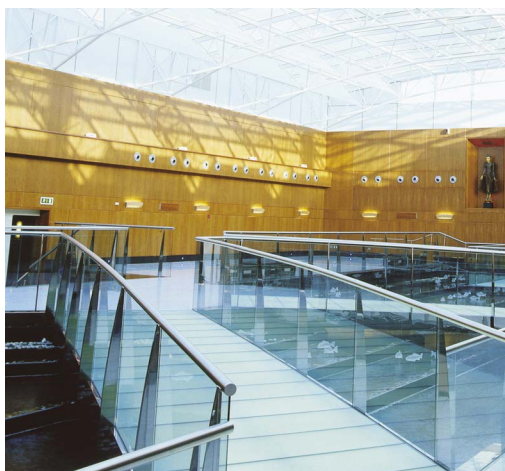

### Case Study

## Facilitate event taps into London's medical expertise

### Background

Phacilitate organises events that deliver knowledge exchange and networking to leaders from the life sciences community. In May 2016, it brought 140 C-suite delegates to London for the Big Data Leaders Europe conference.

### Objectives

To gather together Europe's leading pharmaceutical, biotech and healthcare providers, such as the National Health Service (NHS), with suppliers of data technology and services, and to demonstrate big data's impact on clinical research and drug development.

### Why London

The capital's Tech City, which aims to accelerate the growth of London's and the UK's digital economy, puts London at the heart of tech innovation and gives access to the NHS - one of the largest and health systems in

Europe and a world leader in its field. "We worked closely with DigitalHealth.London, which facilitates the integration of technology into health and academic institutions," Phacilitate's portfolio director James McGough said. "We used Grange City Hotel London, which has excellent meeting space and a great location at Tower Bridge."

### How London & Partners helped

London & Partners marketed the event to Tech City and introduced MedCity, which helped develop the conference agenda and invited key stakeholders from the National Health Service. These connections were vital, allowing MedCity, ECHAlliance and DigitalHealth.London to provide speakers and promote the event to their databases.

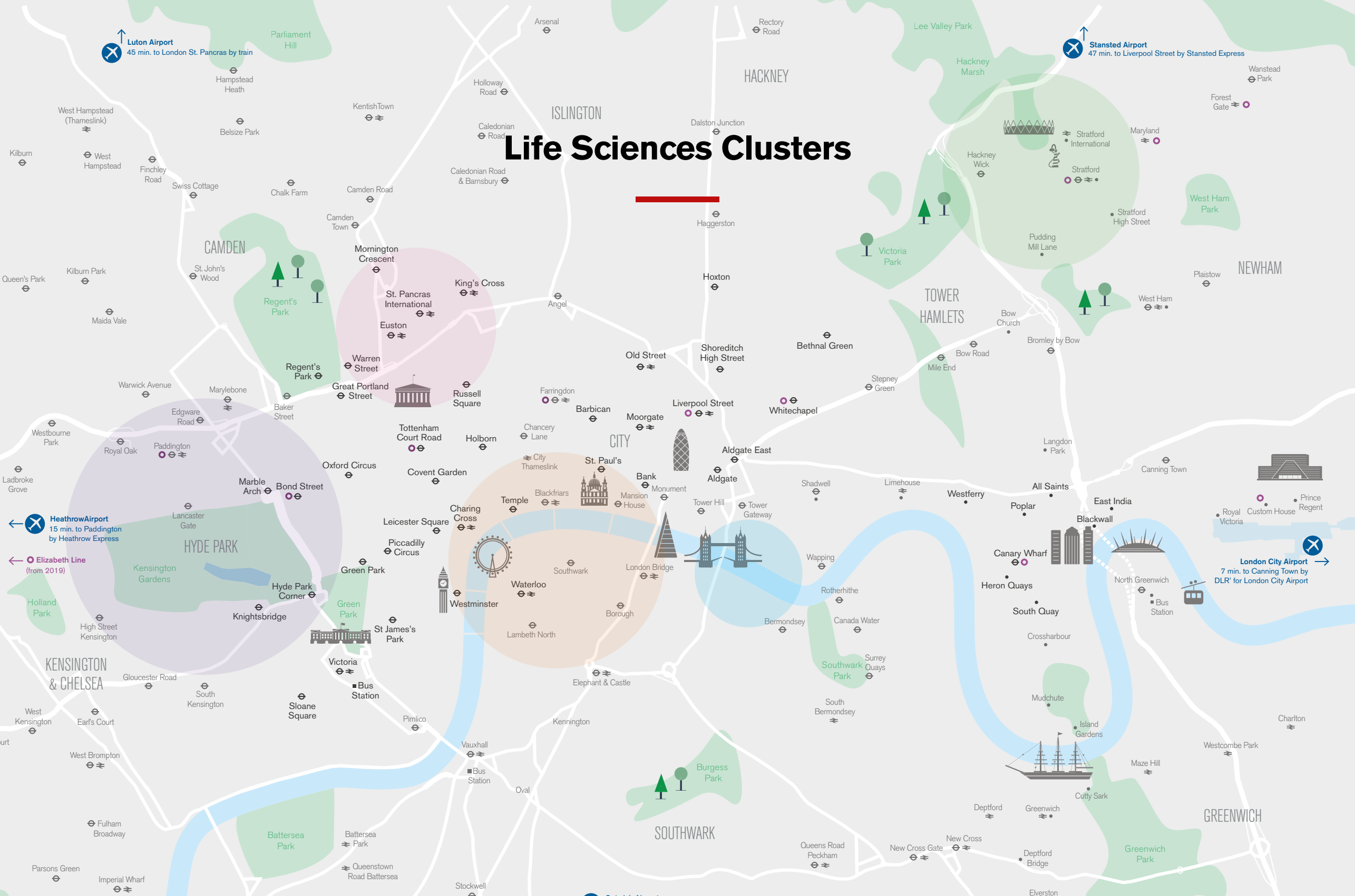
