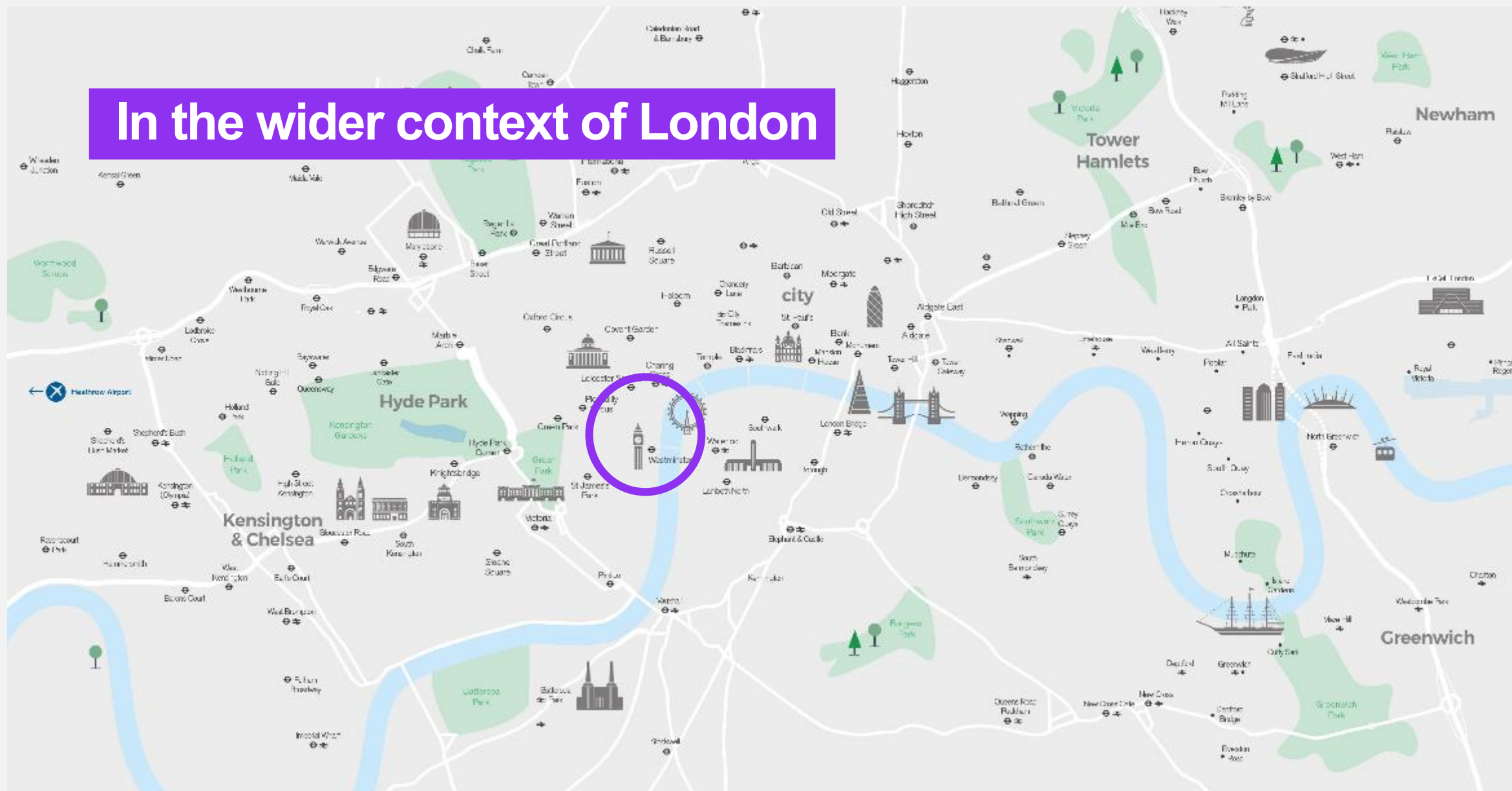

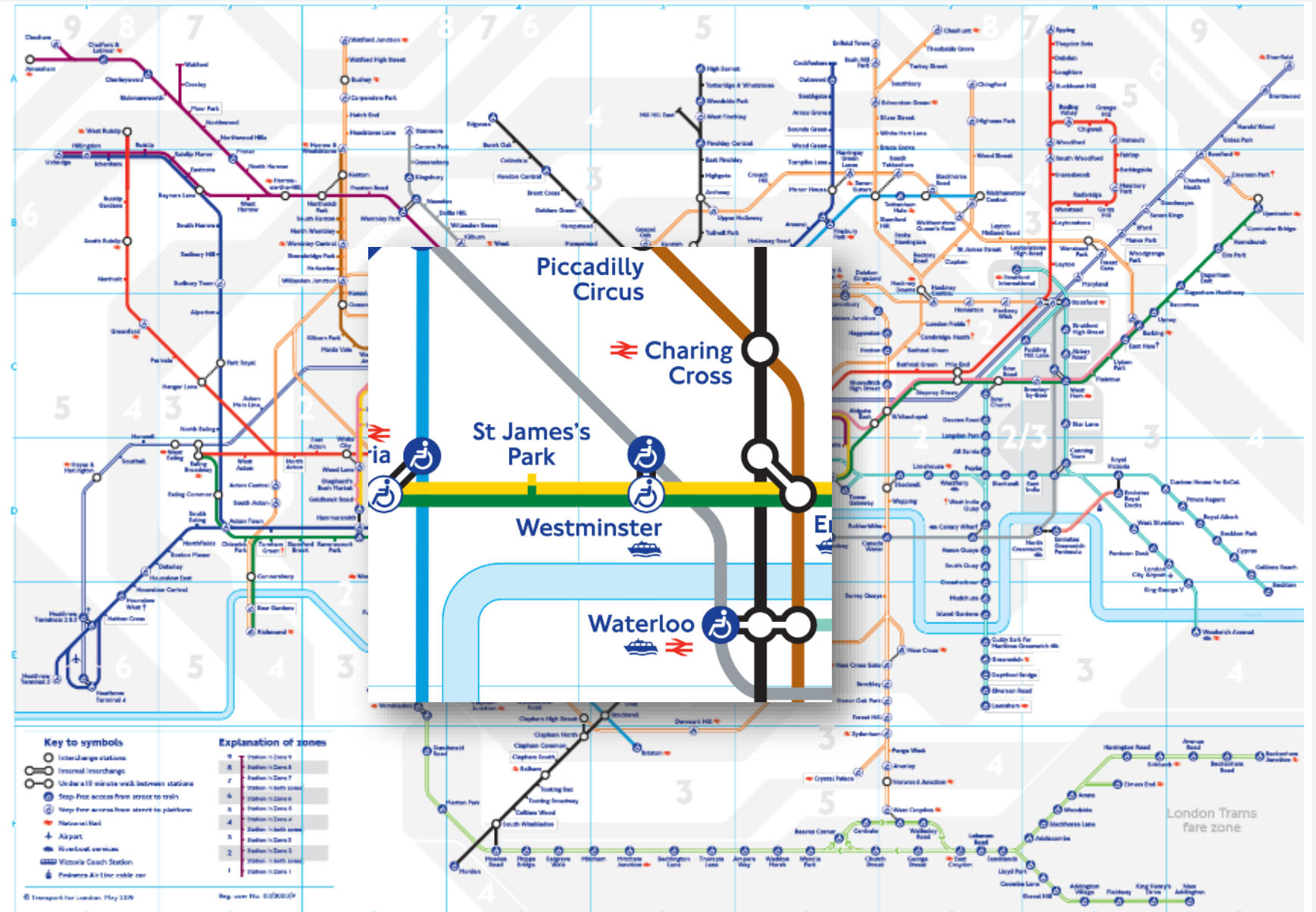

With stunning décor, fine art and motoring heritage, this venue is a sophisticated backdrop for events up to 450 people.



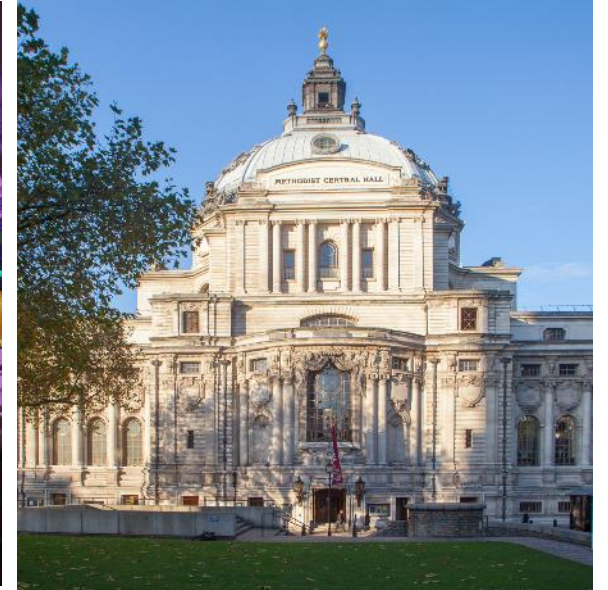
QEII Centre
